
This document will guide the candidate/user who attempts the assessment on the TalentNext platform, which is enabled with remote proctoring.

How to take the test


1. Open your email inbox and check the email notification received from ams-notifications@merittrac.com. You might be having an email similar to what is shown below




2. The email contains information on the portal/Exam link, user login credentials and other details like assessment name, start and end time of the assessment. It also contain min system requirements to attempt this assessment.



3. Click on the candidate Portal/Exam URL, which opens the link in a new tab. Enter the **username and password** from the mail and tick the checkbox “I’m not a robot” and click on **Sign In** button.




4. Once the link opens, check the assessment card/details under **active assessments**. This shows the information about your **assessment name**, the **schedule of the test**, along with **start** and decline buttons. **Click start to begin**.




5. Once you click on the START button, the assessment will load the AI-remote proctoring enabling process

Read the rules, tick the I Agree checkbox, then click on the continue button



Auto Equipment Check, Please click on the Allow button whenever it asks.
Do not interrupt the process in between.

6. After 'Internet Check', select your **Entire screen**, then the **share** option will highlight.



7. Capture your Profile Picture (Ensure that your room is well-lit. Do not cover your face. Do not use goggles or earphones.)

Make sure your face is towards the light and has a clear background; avoid bright backgrounds.



8. Read the Instructions carefully, scroll to the bottom, tick “I agree to the terms and conditions” and click on button start the assessment


- Select the correct answer for each question. Then click ">" button to move to the Next Question.


9. This loads the test. Pointers 1-9 show the options to choose, forward and back buttons, timer for test and see all questions options. The candidate can answer the questions accordingly.


11. This would prompt the confirm button to end the test. You can click on confirm to end the test. Do note that by clicking on this button test will end formally and cannot be revived.
