The highlight of the sporting excursion was PRCAI's collaboration with the Indian Deaf Cricket Association (IDCA) for the second time that further exemplified the organization's commitment to inclusivity, providing specially-abled cricketers a platform to play with mainstream players. IDCA won the Benefit Match against AvianWe Challengers who were 2023 PRPCL North winners, showcasing a spectacular case of will, skill, and determination.

Starting this March, the Public Relations community will get its first-ever PubQuiz by PRCAI. Conducted by QShala and in collaboration with Unboxing Bengaluru, the industry will celebrate the culture and history of the City of Gardens, through friendly yet competitive quiz rounds. The mind sport will excite city quizzers to test their knowledge and connect with industry peers in an informal club setting.
